## **Minimum Requirements for Basic LEDT Training**

1. Commissioned Law Enforcement Officer.
2. A minimum of eight (8) hours classroom instruction.
3. Hold a current Drivers License.
4. 100% attendance and participation.
5. Successfully pass a fifty question multiple choice examination given upon completion of the course. A score of 90% or better is required.
6. Successfully complete course of instruction during the driving portion of the course. This includes no knocking down or touching a cone in at least one of the three runs in the driving maneuvers and maintaining control of the vehicle at all times during the driving maneuvers.
7. Successfully complete the designated cumulative skills courses without knocking down any cones or losing control of the vehicle.
8. The ten (10) following basic maneuvers shall be used:
  - a. Shuffle Steering Maneuver.
  - b. Serpentine Maneuver.
  - c. Evasive Maneuver or The Evasive Maneuver Simulator..
  - d. Controlled Braking Maneuver.
  - e. Backing Maneuver
  - f. Backing Maneuver- opposite direction
  - g. Apex Challenge
  - h. 3pt Turn-Around
  - i. U-Turn Maneuver
  - j. Turn-Around Maneuver

## **Minimum Instructor Course Requirements**

1. Successfully complete an approved Basic LEDT Course.
2. Successfully complete a CLEET Basic Instructor Development Course.
3. A minimum of two (2) years experience as a Certified Law Enforcement Officer
4. Hold a current Drivers License.
5. 100% attendance and participation.
6. Successfully receive a “pass” in all evaluation runs.
7. Successfully score 90% or higher on the written examination and on any cumulative skills acquisition courses.
